

CVYBA Head Travel Coach Contract

CVYBA Head Travel Coach responsibilities include:

- Attending welfare of ALL travel players in the age group.
- Developing 16-22 players in each grade level to be prepared to play middle school basketball for the Cumberland Valley School District.
- Recruiting, selecting and managing all age group Assistant Travel Team Assistant Coaches.
 - Assistant coach selections must be submitted to the Development Coordinators and approved by the CVYBA Board.
- Working with Development Coordinators to schedule practices, games, tournaments, and league play.
- Selecting a roster of players from a group of candidates screened and evaluated by independent evaluators.
- Communicating with parents/guardians of all candidates that were not selected and offering feedback and suggestions for improvement.
- Communicating with parents of rostered players.
- Dividing players and coaches into squads for practices, games, tournaments, and leagues.
 - In 4th grade two even squads shall be formed as “Black” and “White” squads. A “Red Squad” of the strongest players from both teams may be formed for tournament play.
 - In grades 5th through 8th, teams shall be split into “A” and “B” squads with the “A” team referred to as “Red Squad” and the “B” team referred to as “White Squad”.
- Indirect supervision, at a minimum of all practices. Direct supervision of at least one to two monthly practices open to all rostered players.
- Organizing and conducting a parent meeting to review The CVYBA Participant Contract, team policies, playing time policies, uniform sizing, financial commitments, and communication policies.

CVYBA priorities for travel and rec programs include:

- Using basketball as a tool to build character and teach life skills to Cumberland Valley students.
- Fostering new friendships and relationship skills within a team first environment.
- Having fun while enjoying physical activity.
- Encourage and role model community service.

CVYBA basketball goals include:

- Fundamental development of young players.
- Instill the skills and love of competition to promote lifelong *play*... on driveways, playgrounds, and gyms.

- Collaboration with the Cumberland Valley School programs to prepare enough players to fill middle school scholastic basketball rostered with experienced athletes.
- At no level is winning a priority. Hard work, practice, competition, sportsmanship, and the pursuit of excellence is encouraged.

CVYBA policies include:

- Under no circumstances is the criticism of officials acceptable. The only communication with or about officials should be positive.
- Respect for facilities and custodians is paramount. All facilities should be cleaned up thoroughly after use and left in better condition than during arrival.
- Participants should treat all opponents with respect and kindness.
- CVYBA will have Zero tolerance for abusive language or behavior.
- Participant safety trumps all other considerations.
